



*CTEI Resolution II  
June 13, 2019*

*WHEREAS, on July 23, 2018, the U.S. Senate approved legislation to reauthorize the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006; and*

*WHEREAS, on July 31, 2018, the President of the United States signed the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act which authorized Perkins V funding; and*

*WHEREAS, at a series of regional meetings, the Idaho Division of Career Technical Education (ICTE) outlined their transition plan for Perkins V; and*

*WHEREAS, the ICTE state plan excludes Perkins V funding for students in cluster programs;*

*BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that we, the Board of Directors of Career and Technical Educators of Idaho (CTEI) support federal Perkins V language which provides provisions for Perkins V funding for students in cluster courses if districts/consortiums provide access to a pathway.*
